City Ordinances Chapter 69.14 (2) (3) Parking on Front, Side, and Rear Yards

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle, recreational vehicle, machinery or equipment, or trailer in the front yard of any residential lot, unless said property is parked completely upon a driveway or driveway extension.

It shall be unlawful for any person, to park a vehicle, recreational vehicle, machinery or equipment, or trailer in the side or rear yard of any residential lot unless it is on an improved surface consisting of solid concrete, seal coat, asphalt, solid bricks, crushed stone or gravel. Golf cart trailers are allowed in side and back yards.

Grant for Holstein State Theatre!

The Holstein State Theatre was selected to receive a \$100,000 grant from lowa Economic Development to use for improvements to the building and operations. Plans for the project include renovating the "backstage" room behind the movie screen to be used as a party room. Additional lighting will be added to the facade of the theatre, and upgrading the marquee to a digital sign (which will be incorporated into the original marquee, keeping the neon STATE letters).

North Main Community Park

UPDATE!

Work on the North Main Community Park continues with completion of the landscape work within the next two weeks. Α flagpole will be placed in the center planter and a 25-foot Christmas tree for that same planter has been purchased! Benches and tables have been ordered. We continue to fund raise for the additional \$20,000 needed to meet our goal of \$200,000.

Ongoing improvement to this corner by the city will include replacement of the broken concrete with new parking and curbs surrounding the park area. Thank you to all who have supported our efforts and this project!

Ash Tree Removal Customer Compensation

The ash bore beetle has moved into our community and is killing ash trees. This has resulted in many trees that need to be removed which has generated an extensive tree removal list for the city's professional tree removal company.

Per council 9-5-23, a compensation of \$100 per tree for dead, diseased, or dangerous ash trees on city right of way only was approved for property owners who wish to remove said ash trees from the right of way on their property at the property owner's own expense without waiting for the city to remove the tree(s).

Ordinance chapter 151.10 All stump removal and clean-up are the responsibility of the abutting property owner.

If a property owner chooses to remove their dead, diseased, or dangerous ash tree(s) located in the city right of way prior to the city removing the tree(s) and wants the compensation payment, please contact city hall to request

a tree removal permit application. There is no fee for the permit. This permit must be completed and approved PRIOR TO REMOVAL to receive the \$100 compensation.
