MOWING ORDINANCE

MOWING REQUIREMENT (CHAPTER 52) SECTION 52.01

All properties must be mowed and trimmed when grass or vegetation exceeds nine inches. Non-compliance incurs a fee of \$50 per hour (minimum one hour) plus a \$75 surcharge, with unpaid charges added to the property tax bill. Property owners will be notified through an annual publication, and invoices must be paid within 30 days.

Keep It Clean: Grass Clippings and Yard Debris (Chapter 135.03)

It is illegal to dispose of grass clippings, leaves, or debris in streets or alleys in Holstein due to the risk of clogging storm sewers and obstructing water flow, which can lead to flooding and hazards. This ordinance applies regardless of proximity to storm sewers.

Important: Even if your property is not near a storm sewer, the ordinance still applies.

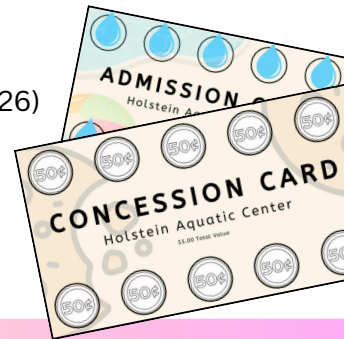
OPENING DAY MAY 24, 2025

Opening Day is May 24th, pending maintenance clearance.

Family season pass covers immediate family only (max. two adults). Dependent children through post-high school summer and college students at home are included. Pass does not cover multiple families, divorced spouses, adult children, grandchildren, cousins, daycare children or friends. One babysitter can be added for free admission when with the family; children 3 and under are free with a paid adult or caretaker. Daycare providers can supervise up to two toddlers; swim diapers required for non-toilet-trained children. Helpers are required for additional children. Non-swimmers with inflatables must have a supervising adult in close proximity; lifejackets from lakes are prohibited.

2025 Pool Pricing:

- Summer Family Pass: \$150 (\$10 off May 24-26)
- Summer Single Pass: \$85 (\$5 off May 24-26)
- Punch Card: 10 visits for \$50
- Day Pass: \$5
- Night Only Pass: \$3
- Concessions Punch Card: \$5
