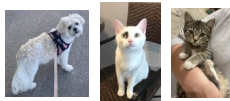

69.12 NO PARKING FOR SNOW REMOVAL

No person shall park, abandon or
leave unattended any vehicle on
any public street, ally, or city-
owned off-street parking area
between the period of November
1 to April 1 between the hours of
2am to 5am. Parking citations will
be issued.

UTILITY BILL CHANGES 5 EXTRA DAYS!

20th of the Month: Utility bill due
date

21st of the Month: Bill is late. A final
notice will be mailed. A penalty of
\$15 will be applied

Disconnect: The city has made a rea-
sonable effort to collect payment

135.12 DUMPING OF SNOW.

It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown,
pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways
onto the traveled way of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutters, or impede the
passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition
therein; except where, in the cleaning of large commercial drives in the business
district it is absolutely necessary to move the snow onto the street or alley tem-
porarily, such accumulation shall be removed promptly by the property owner or
agent. Arrangements for the prompt removal of such accumulations shall be
made prior to moving the snow.

136.03 REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS.

The abutting property owner shall remove snow, ice, and accumulations prompt-
ly from sidewalks. If a property owner does not remove snow, ice or accumula-
tions within a reasonable time, the City may do so and assess the costs against
the property owner for collection in the same manner as a property tax. The
abutting property owner may be liable for damages caused by failure to
remove snow, ice, and accumulations promptly from the sidewalk.
