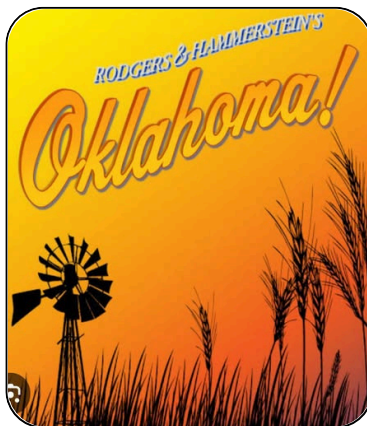

Aquatic Center Policies Clarifications

- Family pass includes immediate family (max 2 adults); excludes multiple families or friends.
- One babysitter can be added to a family pass.
- Minimum age for entry without adult: 9 years.
- Free admission for children 3 and under with a paid adult.
- Daycare providers can supervise two toddlers; additional children require aides.
- Non-toilet trained children must wear swim diapers.
- Non-swimmers with inflatables need adult supervision in the pool.
- Lifejackets from lakes are not permitted.
